

CARE AND CLEANING OF PRE-FINISHED WOOD CABINETRY

Your cabinet finish is formulated to provide an attractive appearance and long lasting protection. These effects will continue to endure with a minimal amount of care. Certain guidelines should be followed:

1. Wipe clean with a damp cloth to remove dust and dirt, and dry with a soft cloth
2. To remove grease and oil, using a soft sponge wet with mild, soapy water. Follow this with a clean, damp cloth to remove any soap residues. Wipe dry with a clean cloth.
3. **Do not** use harsh cleaning fluids, (Fantastic, Windex, 409, Ammonia, etc.). These can harm the finish.
4. Avoid abrasive cleaners, e.g. Comet Cleanser, as they can leave scratches in the finish.
5. Furniture waxes, lemon oils, and polishes vary in composition and **are not** recommended since some of them may damage the finish. They are typically not necessary since our finishes are formulated to retain their original gloss and appearance if these guidelines are followed.
