

PRODUCT WARRANTY

Woodline Cabinets warrants its products against defects in material and workmanship for a period of (1) year from the date of delivery. This warranty does not apply in the case of product damage as the result of misuse, abuse, improper handling or storage and/or improper installation of Woodline Cabinets products nor does it apply to expenses incurred in the removal, shipment, or re-installation of Woodline Cabinets products. This warranty is in lieu of all other implied or expressed warranties.

IMPORTANT INFORMATION

Finish Characteristics – Our cabinetry is constructed using many pieces of solid wood and veneers. Because no two trees look alike, authentic woods can vary in color and character markings such as streaks, knots and grain patterns. Since stains may attract differently to these grain patterns, some natural light and dark areas may result. The beauty lies in these natural variations of color and grain that give each cabinet its own individual charm. The beauty of these products is protected with a furniture quality exterior finish. After a period of time, there may be changes in the finish color as it ages in its surrounding conditions. Due to this natural aging process, the finish can also “deepen” over time, darkening the color of the wood or creating a “shadowing” effect where doors overlap the frame. These are inherent characteristics of the finish, and the natural aging process adds to the unique appearance of the cabinetry. Due to these minor differences in tone, it may not be possible to match the finish color of existing cabinets when replacing doors or adding cabinets at a later date.

Natural Finish – Natural finishes highlight the inherent qualities of genuine wood to create a truly beautiful product. It is important to realize that the beauty of clear finished cabinetry really comes from the natural qualities of wood itself. Only select solid hardwoods and hardwood veneers are used to construct our cabinetry. The beauty of these genuine woods lies in the variation of color and grain. Shadings of white, red, black, yellow and even green may be visible. Mineral streaks may also add to the distinctive appearance, reflecting the tree’s “life history” as it absorbed minerals differently from one area to another. Grain and apparent texture may range from even and consistent to varied and dramatic. These natural variations result in unique character markings on adjacent cabinets, on pairs of doors and even within the same panel. These variations can also appear on edges of hardwood doors where solid lumber cores are exposed in certain styles. We point out these unique characteristics of natural finishes to emphasize that each piece of wood is different and the varied effect of naturally finished cabinetry in a complete kitchen or bath may be different from that represented by a smaller display or finish sample. The variations are broad, and that is where the beauty of natural wood lies.

Thermofoil – Thermofoil cabinetry features doors and drawer fronts surfaced with a durable thermofoil (PVC) that is colored throughout. This finish surface allows for years of outstanding wear and beauty. Thermofoil cabinetry also features face frames constructed of solid wood with a colored lacquer finish. Since woods naturally expand and contract with changes in temperature and humidity, some visible cracks may eventually form in the area of cabinet joints. Since thermofoil doors and drawer fronts are fabricated with different materials than the solid wood face frames, the natural aging process may cause the two products to show some color variations. The levels of exposure to sunlight, smoke and household chemicals will all have an impact on the color variation.
